Thank you for your continued support of ACCA throughout the year.

We are extremely grateful for all of your help and kind donations, and are putting the money we have raised to good use to improve the lives of disadvantaged children throughout the Algarve.

This year we launched the back to school programme, providing children with essential school materials and it was a great success. We tried to give each child the basics (bags, exercise books, pens, etc) but each pack also contained something special (a sparkly pencil, cool rubber or similar) to brighten their day.

The Angel programme, (which ensures that children in care receive at least one present for Christmas,) continues to grow. This year we provided presents for 1400 children, who were truly grateful for your generosity on Christmas day.

Our charity Christmas cards, designed by children from the homes we support, and produced thanks to four extremely kind sponsors, proved popular, selling out completely and raising over 600 euros.

We also raised 16000 euros as The Masters official charity, which they matched, giving a grand total of 32000 euros. We will spend this money on a variety of urgent projects including refurbishing bathroom facilities in two children's homes in Faro and Alvor, where conditions are desperate, as well as providing medical treatment to many individual children.

### PRO TIP by Ross Sutherland

### Start The Downswing With Left Knee

How to deliver the club property from inside the target line

If you're having trouble keeping your swing consistent when a match is on the line, key on your left knee to start your downswing.

When you practise, remember to support your backswing with your right leg, then move your left knee and thigh first laterally, then rotationally, to your left. This allows your arms to drop the club inside the target line on the downswing for long and consistent shots.
