PRO TIP by Kenny Fairbairn

Buried lie in a bunker

Move the ball back in your stance to a point just inside your right heel.

Grip the club a little more firmly than normal.

Align the clubface square or even closed to the hole.

Then turn your left shoulder under your chin.

Combined with the adjusted ball position, this leads to your picking the club up quickly with your arms – not with an abrupt breaking of the wrists.

Coming down, hit hard with your right hand.

The club enters the sand at an acute angle and so your follow-through will be short.

The ball will run further on hitting the green, so try to allow for it.
