## Report from the Greens Committee

Last month we reported that the course was improving, but essentially it was still "work in progress". It is much better than it was six months ago; the greens are fast and firm, and the tees are much improved with hand cutting, over seeding and feeding.

The difficult issue the club faces is how we deal with course maintenance over the coming year. I will try to highlight the areas of concern:

- 1. We need more investment in machinery to keep the Kikuyu grass looking and playing like a top course. Christophe has recognised the need for investment and applied for an increased budget. Modern machinery is expensive and the figures are high!
- 2. Drainage on Olives is poor, as is fairway growth. Either we need new drains or, as suggested by our consultant agronomist, an application of calcium has greatly improved drainage on other courses with a similar problem. We are going to try it!
- 3. The greens are fast but still lack fertility, in some cases at root level. We have been advised that we should hollow tine the greens (not micro tine) and apply an organic dressing

ideally once or twice a year. Micro tining works with sand but not so well with organic material. The problem is that this is disruptive and nine holes may need to be closed for several days at a very busy time for the club. The committee would support temporary disruption but it is an obvious issue! Sisenando suggests using injected liquid fertiliser but the writer is not convinced it is as good?

- 4. We are changing all the sprinkler heads, which is both a huge job and expensive. The new heads are much better but it takes time at least another 12 months.
- 5. The fairways have all been hollow tined for the first time, in some cases for many years. We need warm weather and rain with a planned feeding regime to see how we can get improved growth. Another two months will give some indication as to whether we are on the correct path!

Finally the Captain and I met our agronomist who remains very interested in the course and wants to help with its recovery. The writer hopes to meet Carlos Rocha in the next few weeks to discuss budgets.

We have had a cool and very dry winter and still no sign of rain. The green staff are working hard with a tidy course and new nesting boxes in some trees to encourage caterpillar eating birds (yes, really). We cannot alter nature but we could use the help!

Gordon Todd has been targeting some cosmetic changes on the course, which will improve visibility and course appearance. Tony Hickey is already adding his experience as a golf course owner, which is to be welcomed.

#### Starting the Downswing

The correct start down begins in the lower half of the body – the legs and the hips.

That is why telling clients to "stay sat down" in the backswing and to "get the left heel down first" in the downswing, is often good advice. Doing so consolidates the anchor point of the feet and starts the hips swinging back into and through the address position early.

This automatically begins to pull on the arms and hands, and unwinds them towards the ball. The perfect sequence.
