Dear Members,



APPA arranged their 4th Annual Social event which took place on 12th September at Ilha Deserta. There were 42 Members and guests taking part in a very nice lunch organized by the APPA President Roger Kitson and many thanks to him on behalf of all present.

On the 16th and 17th of September, Pinheiros Altos hosted the annual international Ronald McdDonald Charity event which saw 320 players participate over two days. PRO TIP by Kenny Fairbairn

SHAFT IN PALM FOR PUTTING

In a Putting Stroke, the handle of the Putter should be in your palms, along the lifelines.

This lines up the shaft with your forearms – putting it in the proper position for it to swing on the right plane.

With this position the reverse overlap grip works perfectly with the club in the lifelines. You will feel a lot of open spaces between the hands and the grip, but don't worry – the Putter will be secure!
