### PRO TIP by Kenny Fairbarin

#### Fast Greens (Downhill Putts)

As we approach Christmas and the Pinheiros greens quicken, here is a little tip that may help on those downhill putts that scare the life out of you.

I simply address and strike the putt off the toe of the blade. This has the effect of deadening the contact between the club and the ball. There is no need for me to alter my stroke or to decelerate into the putt.

I can, in effect, stroke the ball normally with only a small amount of pace taken out of the putt.
