Putting

Strangely enough, standard length of putters you can buy in the shops tend to be 35 inches, but in general this is too long for the vast majority of players.

Try a little test, grip the putter and try to line up your left and right forearms as a straight extension of the grip. To do



this, you may have to grip down your current putter. This will give you a better guide to the correct length and lie of putter that you should be using.

Report from the Greens Committee

In our November report we detailed the challenges facing the green staff arising from the condition of the course and the "dollar spot" contagion in particular.

Our comments have not gone unnoticed and there has been intensive work on the course to speed recovery. It is a fact,"that before things can get better they often have to get worse!"

The programme agreed to was that after the "dollar spot" had been eliminated, the greens were to be micro tined, followed by an application of feed. Then lightly scarified and followed by an application of top organic dressing and over seeded. A similar programme was put in place for the tees with a general application of fertilizer for the whole course.

This has now taken place. The greens have also been rolled for the Portuguese PGA competition this week and are running at 11 on the stimp, which is "quick"... and the scores suggest the pros are not just coping but enjoying the conditions with first round scores of under par for the top six players.

There is still some way to go and whilst the weather has been helpful to date, colder nights may slow the recovery. Rolling the greens does help to smooth the imperfections. Turning to the tees, there have been general improvements and some are indeed very good, although others still require more work. The regime of feeding and hand-cutting will recommence, and we expect much better presentation by the spring, if not before!

The fairways are being hollow tined (this reflects a change of mind by management) and whilst we are "placing", this will help to encourage growth and root development, particularly as the fairways have also been fertilised.

There is, therefore a lot happening on the course and we must be patient before we see the results of the work.

Lastly, management is considering the committees suggestions for tightening up the course presentation. I must thank Tony Hickey for all his work in this respect. It will involve more man hours and we understand it requires consideration, but we are already seeing evidence of better presentation.

We believe members will see real improvements when we next report.
